Approval of the Minutes: Minutes of the May 8, 2012 meeting were approved.

COMMISSION/COMMITTEE REPORTS:

Finance & Administration:

George O'Connor reported for the Finance Committee (report attached). He said that with 53 Sundays and Christmas falling midweek, collections are budgeted at \$1,325,000 for fiscal year 2012-2013. Staff salaries include a 2.5% increase and there is no budget change for benefit expense. The budget allowance for financial aid to Holy Souls School families decreased to \$65,000. Social Concerns budget is \$26,000, based on the current formula of 2% of prior year income. A motion was made, seconded and the budget for 2012-2013 was approved.

Building and Grounds:

Mary Carman reported for the Building and Grounds Committee. She said that the Parish Hall project will be completed this week. In addition, the 6th and 8th grades renovation project is in process. Smart boards will be added to eight classrooms. Mary requested that schedule requests be sent to her as soon as possible.

Education and Formation Commission:

Robert Magri reported for the Education and Formation Commission (minutes attached). Robert said that the main focus of the meeting was to discuss promoting Summer Speak and developing an Adult Faith Formation Program. The Summer Speak will begin on July 11th and 25th and August 8th. In addition, Robert mentioned that Holy Souls has no programs in place for the young adults (18-35). Suggestions were made at the meeting to invite some young adults to the next commission meeting for their ideas and input. Also, Christ the King has a young adult program called "Terra Firma" which is successful. Possibly contacting them was also suggested.

Liturgy Commission:

There was no report from the Liturgy Commission.

Parish Life Commission:

Paula Wellborn reported for the Parish Life Commission. The recent Coffee and Donuts gathering was very successful! A thank you to the Mens Club for funding these gatherings. It was suggested to possibly move Coffee and Donuts to the outside, weather permitting. The next Blood Drive will be July 1st.

Social Concerns Commission:

Darlene Hebda reported for the Social Concerns Commission (minutes attached). Darlene said the minutes contained their Pastoral Plan updates. In addition, a list of 16 organizations were recommended to receive either \$1,000 or \$2,000 for submitted grant approvals.
