Finance & Administration – Shelley reported the church is doing well—is up \$182,000. Deaconate training and rodent eradication expenses were not in the original budget for this year. The Capital Campaign has received \$750,000 in pledges and \$64,000 in gifts thus far.

Buildings & Grounds Committee – Susie is working on pricing and quotes for the items on the Capital Campaign list. The playground mural is complete and looks great. Prepping for all the work to be performed during the summer has started.

Education & Evangelization – The minutes were previously emailed. Samantha reported that the church mission was very successful with 160 people the first night.

Parish Life –April 15 is the Altar Servers dinner and the graduating seniors dinner.

Social Concerns – Grant invitations have gone out and are due by May 1. The Feast of Corpus Christi is upcoming.

Old Business - None.

New Business –Nominees for new members are needed. Jeff, Tamara, Chris, and Jane will all be rotating off the council. Samantha suggested creating a committee specifically for Youth Faith Formation since it is has split from Adult Faith Formation. Cindy suggested possibly combining the Parish Life and Social Concerns committees. It was also suggested to have a school board member be a part of the Parish Council.

Fr John— The Capital Campaign is going well. Everyone needs to make an equal sacrifice and we will continue to move forward.
