Presenters:

Michael Copas is a parishioner at Immaculate Conception, and president of the newly formed Christian Society for Philosophy and Theology. He was instrumental in bringing Scott Hahn to Holy Souls in February. Raised Catholic, Michael left the Church in 1999. He did undergraduate and graduate in biblical exegesis, history, and theology at Ouachita Baptist University and Wheaton College. During his studies, he became convinced of the truths of the Catholic Church and returned to the Church in 2012.

Cackie Upchurch taps into years of experience in Bible study and adult faith formation to share the life-giving message of Scripture. She serves as director of Little Rock Scripture Study, is the general editor of the Little Rock Catholic Study Bible, an associate editor of The Bible Today and contributor to Give Us This Day. She is the author of four volumes of the Alive in the Word series: Mary, Favored by God; Moses, Called and Equipped; Hospitality: Welcoming the Stranger and Christmas: Season of Wonder and Hope. She speaks at conferences and leads retreats around the country. She holds two degrees in Theology and multiple hours of ongoing education in the field.

Dc. Matt Glover grew up at Holy Souls, and graduated from Loyola University in New Orleans with a degree in Philosophy and Religious Studies. He earned a masters degree in Sacred Theology from the Pontifical Gregorian University, a law degree from the William H. Bowen School of Law, and a Licentiate in Canon Law from Catholic University of America in Washington, D.C. He currently serves as Chancellor for Canonical Affairs and General Consul for the Diocese and is a Deacon assigned to Christ the King parish in Little Rock.
