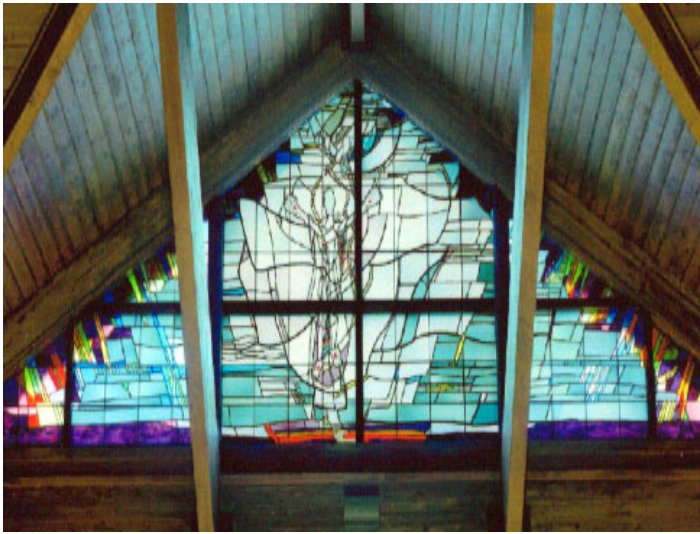

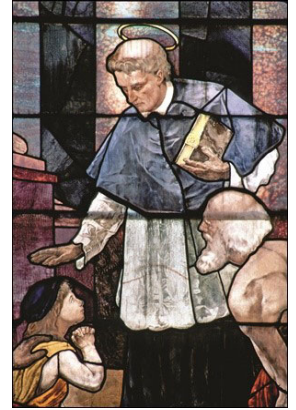

Saint Vincent de Paul

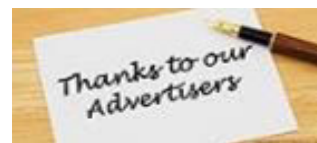


FEAST DAY:

Prisoners, Volunteers

- + St. Vincent **established organizations of men and women to provide aid to the poor and sick. He depended on the donations of the wealthy, who made it possible for him to found hospitals and orphanages.**
 - In 1625 in Paris: the **Congregation of the Missions (the Vincentians)** a society of **priests** charged with **missionary efforts, the training of clergy, and preaching** among the country people.
 - Ignorance and lack of discipline were prevalent among those who first joined, but Vincent was able to **light them on fire with passion and zeal in their work for the people.**
 - In 1633: the **Sisters of Charity, the first congregation of women outside of the convent to care for the sick and poor.**
- + During his life, these groups' membership **increased in number and spread across the world!**
- + He **collected money for victims of war and ransomed over 1200 slaves** from North Africa.

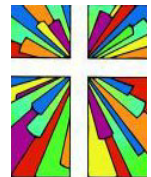
